


Jupiter Double Moon Transits (MDT)

# Astronomical League Mercury Transit Special Award

- Mercury Transit on 09 May so start planning now (next one NOV 11, 2019)
  - Requirements:
    - Calculate distance from Mercury to the Sun in AU
    - Collect the observations
    - Measure the parallax angle
    - Calculate the distance between two observing locations
    - Calculate the value of AU
